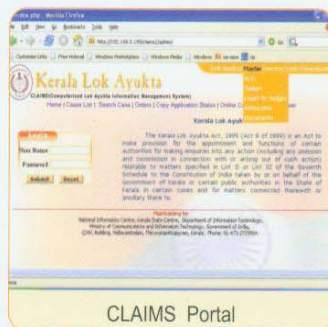

## Kerala Lok Ayukta Act

The Kerala Lok Ayukta Act, 1999 (Act 8 of 1999) is an Act to make provision for the appointment and functions of certain authorities for making inquiries into any action (including any omission and commission in connection with or arising out of such action) related to matters specified in the Constitution of India taken by or on behalf of the Government of Kerala or certain public authorities in the State of Kerala in certain cases and for matters connected therewith or ancillary there to.

Kerala Lok Ayukta is constituted with one Lok Ayukta and two Upa Lok Ayuktas.

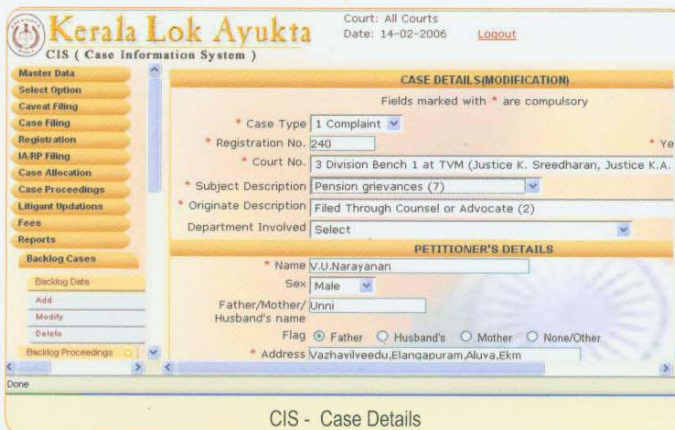
## CLAIMS

The CLAIMS is one of the open source initiatives of NIC Kerala. The software is developed as LAMP based system. This application can be implemented in any of the Lok Ayuktas across the country.

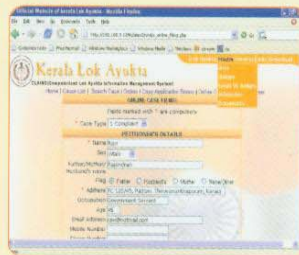
